With the gradual subsidence of the COVID-19 pandemic, the College strives back to normal and continues to work hard for our mission of promoting the highest standard of cardiovascular patient care and heart health of people of Hong Kong. With the concerted and dedicated effort of the Council Members of the Hong Kong College of Cardiology, I am extremely grateful and proud to look back and share with you our rich and fruitful journey in professional education and heart health promotion in the past year!

We continue to have a strong collaboration with international cardiac societies and local organizations in synergizing the outcomes of professional education. American College of Cardiology (ACC), Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology, British Cardio-Oncology Society, European Society of Cardiology and Korean Society of Cardiology keep working closely with us in producing high-quality joint sessions in the Annual Scientific Congress. Best of ACC, 2022 was held in Hong Kong in October last year. Ten years passed, Hong Kong College of Cardiology and Asia Pacific Heart Rhythm Society (APHRS) join forces again to organize the 16th APHRS & CardioRhythm 2023 in Hong Kong in September 2023.

Apart from outside support, internal chapters , especially newly established chapters also develop rapidly: Cardiovascular Intervention Chapter keeps 4 fellow courses per year and Hong Kong Complex Cardiovascular Intervention (HKCCI) will hold the 5th meeting in physical format in September 2023 to enhance the standard of cardiovascular intervention in Hong Kong. Co-organizing with the Hong Kong Association of Sports Medicine and Sports Science, Sports and Exercise Cardiology Chapter held a one-day symposium in a hybrid format last year. Adult Congenital Heart Diseases Chapter continues to organize scientific meetings by involving overseas faculties to share experiences. Moreover, coming to the 15th Anniversary, Paediatric Cardiology Chapter upkeeps its objectives to promote the advancement of knowledge and science of paediatric cardiology to paediatric cardiologists and trainees. A half-day symposium, co-organized with the Hong Kong Society of Neuromuscular Diseases, was successfully held on 7 January 2023.

Advocacy of heart health in the community of Hong Kong is an important mission of our College. An annual highlighted public event World Heart Day Carnival cum Run for Heart will be held at Hong Kong Science Park on 23 October 2023. Besides, Jump Rope For Heart Programme also continues to

Report Summary



Report Summary



Since its foundation in 1992, the Hong Kong College of Cardiology (the College) has been continuing its mission to promote the advancement of cardiovascular medicine and public health through scientific, professional, educational activities and international collaboration. Its ultimate goal is to promote the heart health of Hong Kong people and to develop and maintain good practice of cardiovascular medicine by ensuring the highest professional standards of competence and ethical integrity.

The first symposium co-organized by the College and Hong Kong Association of Sports Medicine and Sports Science was successfully held on 30 October 2022 in hybrid format with over 370 faculty and participants attended. Before the end of 2022, the 9th Asian Preventive Cardiology and Cardiac Rehabilitation Conference (APCCRC) was held from 26-27 November 2022. This biennial meeting provided an excellent opportunity for sharing of experience in a broad range of topics in preventive cardiology and cardiac rehabilitation for doctors and allied health professionals in Hong Kong and other parts of the world. The College continued to co-organize the Hong Kong Core Cardiology Certificate Course with the Hong Kong Public Hospital Cardiologists Association. Second Cycle Module 1 and Module 2 were held on 29 January 2023 and 30 April 2023 respectively.

The last Asia Pacific Heart Rhythm Society (APHRS) Scientific Session was held in Hong Kong 10 years ago in 2013. The two societies, APHRS and the College, joined hands again to host this important congress this year. With the theme "Embracing the Breakthroughs", APHRS 2023 will be held from 1-3 September 2023, featuring sharing of cutting-edge science, demonstration of advanced and novel techniques; and interaction among international experts in the field of heart rhythm management. The 3-day scientific programme covered the latest development in cardiac pacing, implantable cardioverter defibrillators, atrial fibrillation and ventricular tachyarrhythmia, and innovation in mapping and ablation of cardiac arrhythmia. It also included meet-the-experts sessions and a number of joint sessions with different societies.

The 31st Annual Scientific Congress (ASC) of the College together with 10th Congregation was held from 16-18 June 2023. This was the first ASC after the pandemic with an encouraging over 800 registrations. Many renowned international experts in cardiovascular medicine contributed to a highly educational and provocative program. Strong international collaboration was one of the hallmarks, as exemplified by joint sessions with the American College of Cardiology, Asian Pacific Society of Cardiology, European Society of Cardiology, Korean Society of Cardiology and British Cardio-

Oncology Society. Having postponed for a year, the 10th Congregation was held on 17 June 2023,

marking another historical moment of the College.

To strengthen and enhance the core missions of the College, the Scientific Committee and Public Health Education Committee continue to promote professional education and public health education in heart diseases. Both committees involve many of our younger enthusiastic fellows. Throughout the year, the College and its various chapters have also organized local scientific programmes which have

all been very well received and well attended.

The College has also actively organized various community activities to promote cardiovascular

health. The Jump Rope for Heart Program continues its recruitment of school children for the

promotion of heart health through rope skipping. Several other activities for heart health promotion

were also launched. The World Heart Day Carnival cum Run for Heart, which is scheduled to be held

on 23 October 2023, will create a yearly climax of heart health promotion to the general public in

Hong Kong.

Regarding professional training, the College continues to support cardiology trainees and fellows to

pursue advanced training in cardiovascular medicine in world-renowned overseas centres through the

Hong Kong Heart Foundation Cardiology Training Fellowship Programme and Dr. C O PUN and Dr.

Mary B L KWONG Scholarship.

The diversified and calendar-full activities organized by the College would not be successful without

the dedication and active participation of its members, support of friends and the contribution of

leading practitioners and academics both locally and abroad. Hereby the Council would like to take

this opportunity to express gratitude to all our members and supporters. The College will pledge to

continue her mission with clear and strong will in the years to come.

Top Late Breaking Clinical Trials of ACC.22 - Hong Kong, 8 - 9 October 2022

To echo the overwhelming response of the last conference, Hong Kong College of Cardiology worked closely with the American College of Cardiology to organize their 2nd virtual conference which is the Top Late Breaking Clinical Trials of ACC.22 - Hong Kong on 8 - 9 October 2022.

The two half-day programme offered diversified licensed content from the ACC's Annual Scientific Meeting 2022 and was designed to deliver Late Breaking Clinical Trials (LBCT) by the international principal investigators & research team members to help local and regional cardiologists and other cardiovascular team members staying up-to-date on the newest clinical research. The top experts also debated and discussed the outcomes of leading-edge trials during the conference and explained how it all fits into current cardiology practice. Almost 150 participants attended the conference. 58% interviewees are extremely satisfactory on the event.

HKCC HKASMSS Sports and Exercise Cardiology Symposium, 30 October 2022

Co-organized with Hong Kong Association of Sports Medicine and Sports Science, HKCC HKASMSS Sports and Exercise Cardiology Symposium, the 1st symposium of the chapter was successfully held on 30 October 2022 in New World Millennium Hong Kong Hotel (hybrid format). The theme was "Safe Exercise During COVID: From Wellness to Performance". The symposium was well-received with 374 faculty and participants attended.

We were honoured to have three overseas speakers, Dr. Andre La Gerche, who is the Head of Clinical Research Domain at Baker Heart and Diabetes Institute, Director of National Centre for Sports Cardiology and Cardiologist in St. Vincent's Hospital Melbourne; Prof. Timothy C. WONG, who is the Assistant Professor of Medicine at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine and Cardiologist at the UPMC Heart and Vascular Institute; Ms. Victoria BACON, who is a licensed and certified genetic counselor in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

The 9th Asian Preventive Cardiology & Cardiac Rehabilitation Conference was successfully held on 26-27 November 2022 at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre via a HYBRID format with both physical and virtual participation.

The COVID-19 pandemic was an unprecedented global health crisis and cardiovascular health was jeopardized. The theme of APCCRC this year was "Long COVID in Cardiovascular Disease Management and Cardiac Rehabilitation", featuring a comprehensive programme in preventive cardiology and cardiac rehabilitation. Joint sessions with Chinese Association of Rehabilitation Medicine, International Council of Cardiovascular Prevention and Rehabilitation, Japanese Association of Cardiac Rehabilitation and Singapore Heart Foundation were held during the Conference for sharing of experience and exchanging of ideas among experts from Hong Kong and different countries. Riding on the success of the previous conferences, workshops for allied healthcare professionals and the public education sessions for patients, their carers and other citizens were organized again this year.

Background

One of the most important missions of Hong Kong College of Cardiology (HKCC) is to promote the training and standard of our cardiology professionals so as to translate into better clinical patient care.

In view of the vast and tremendous explosions in knowledge with ever increasing new advances, it is becoming increasingly difficult for cardiologists and fellow trainees to stay abreast and keep up to date on core knowledge as well as new frontier technology.

However, the prerequisite of top-quality patient care depends highly on core clinical knowledge and experience. Therefore, HKCC determines to launch this first-of-its-kind certificate training course in 2018 and starts the 2nd cycle in 2023. We are pleased to have Hong Kong Public Hospital Cardiologists Association (HKPHCA), which shares similar aims, to co-organize the course.

Goal

The goal of the course is for our cardiology professionals to enhance their core cardiology knowledge and skill in day-to-day clinical practice.



Course Description

The Course consists of 9 modules, each of one-day duration, over the period of 3 years. It provides a comprehensive broad base and up-to-date review of clinical diseases and the management. Topics include general cardiology, coronary artery disease, arrhythmia, valvular & pericardial disease, heart failure & cardiomyopathy, congenital heart disease, hypertension, perioperative consult, clinical electrophysiology, core echocardiographic & interventional knowhow & tips, critical cardiac care, and pearls of wisdom from the experts. Approach to common symptoms, intelligent use of investigations and tips & tricks in intervention & device usage will be highlighted. The course also serves as good review for trainees to prepare for cardiology examinations.

Target Participants

All cardiologists in clinical practice and fellow trainees will benefit from the course. Due to limited capacity and to allow more interaction, fellows in training who are also members of HKCC / HKPHCA have priority for enrollment.

Certification

A short examination will be held at the end of each module. Delegates passing the examination will get a certificate of that module. Upon completion and passing examination of at least 6 out of 9 modules, delegate will get a certificate for the Course.

Progress

All but one of the 9 modules in the 1st cycle were held physically. They were all very well received with most delegates stayed through the whole day program and provided excellent feedback.

Due to overwhelming responses for participation, the capacity for most modules had to be expanded to around 80 or more to accommodate for request from enthusiastic members.

The 1st module of HKCCCCII was successfully held physically and attended by 64 cardiologists and trainees. A total of 38 attendees took the examination and all of them passed. Online evaluation forms were distributed after the course and received 19 completed forms. Most of them strongly agreed the course had achieved its stated objectives, met their training needs and was practical for use in their workplace. The course was clearly and logically organized. Overall, all the interviewees were satisfied with the course.

16th Asia Pacific Heart Rhythm Society (APHRS) Scientific Session, 1-3 September 2023

The 16th Asia Pacific Heart Rhythm Society (APHRS) Scientific Session, in conjunction with CardioRhythm 2023, will be held in Hong Kong from 1 to 3 September 2023. The Meeting is organized by the Asia Pacific Heart Rhythm Society (APHRS) and the Hong Kong College of Cardiology (HKCC), coorganized by the Chinese Society of Pacing and Electrophysiology (CPSE).

The APHRS is the first and only society organized in the Asia-Pacific region to promote excellence and advancement in diagnosis and treatment of patients with heart rhythm disease. The annual scientific session is the highlight of its activities. The last joint meeting in Hong Kong was held exactly 10 years ago in 2013.

Jump Rope for Heart Program (JRFH) (跳繩強心) 2022-2023

In this academic year (2022-2023), 70 schools (48 primary schools, 13 secondary schools, 8 kindergartens and 1 international school) have joined Jump Rope for Heart Program. As schools could only resume whole-day schooling in the 2nd semester, extra-curricular activities were greatly hindered and thus the JRFH participation rate as well as fund raising activities were largely affected. Some schools even applied for one-year postponement as the school calendar was hugely influenced.

School visits by expert team were conducted in 29 schools in this academic year. Very positive feedback was received. Students were all amazed by the wonderful performance of our elite skippers and thus showed great interest in learning rope skipping. More importantly, students learnt how to keep a healthy heart by adopting healthy lifestyle such as doing regular exercise, eating balanced and healthy diets and no smoking.

JRFH online rope skipping competition (2022/2023) was held from 1 December 2022 to 15 January 2023. The competition was divided into 18 groups (kinder girls / kinder boys / P1 girls / P1 boys / P2 girls / P2 boys / P3 girls / P3 boys / P4 girls / P4 boys / P5 girls / P5 boys / P6 girls / P6 boys / S1-3 girls / S1-3 boys / S4-6 girls / S4-6 boys). Each participant may join 1 to 5 events. The entry fee for each event was HK\$100. A total of 845 participants joined the competition. Winners were invited to join the final round at JRFH Inter-school Rope Skipping Competition in July 2023.

JRFH Inter-school Rope Skipping Competition 2023 was successfully held on 2 July 2023 (Sun) and 9 July 2023 (Sun) at Heung To Middle School (Tin Shui Wai). 33 primary schools were divided into Group A / Group B / Group C @11 teams whereas 18 secondary schools were divided into Group A / Group B @9 teams. Winners of JRFH online rope skipping competition (2022/2023) were invited to individual speed events final round. Representatives from HKCC, Department of Health, Education Bureau and Hong Kong Rope Skipping Association, China formed the honorary judge panel. Dr. Godwin LEUNG and Dr. Kenneth NG attended the event on behalf of HKCC on 2 July and 9 July respectively.

The Rotary Club CPR & AED Education Project 2022/2023 was jointly organized by HKCC, Rotary Club of Hong Kong Northeast and St. John Ambulance Association for the 6th year. Dr. Godwin LEUNG attended the opening ceremony on behalf of HKCC on 19 November 2022 at St. John Headquarters. As agreed, JRFH helped to recruit teachers to join the course. A total of 120 teachers attended the course on 24 & 25 June 2023.

The Joyful Fruit Month – School Fruit Promotion Project is jointly organized by HKCC and Department of Health and supported by JRFH. A maximum of HK\$2,000 is granted to a maximum of 75 schools per year. In 2022, 71 schools received a total of HK\$118,932.6 as funding. HKCC Council approved granting HK\$150,000 (a maximum of HK\$2,000 for 75 secondary schools) for the project again in 2023.

The Hong Kong Rope Skipping Association, China has sent a letter to HKCC seeking sponsorship for the HK Delegation participating in World Jump Rope Championship 2023 in July 2023. The HKCC council decided to sponsor a maximum of HK\$250,000 to support the HK athletes. As a token of recognition and appreciation, the logo of HKCC would be printed on the team uniform and on the official website of HKRSA, forum of HK Delegation joining WJRC 2023 and all related promotional materials.




