Report Summary

Since its foundation in 1992, the Hong Kong College of Cardiology has been continuing its mission to promote the advancement of cardiovascular medicine and public benefit through scientific, professional, educational activities and international communication and cooperation. Its ultimate goal is to promote awareness of heart health to Hong Kong people, and to develop and maintain good practice of cardiovascular medicine by ensuring the highest professional standards of competence and ethical integrity.

Heart Rhythm Refresher Courses were held regularly to enable qualified cardiologists to refresh and keep up to date with current management of cardiac arrhythmias. The 6th Asian Preventive Cardiology & Cardiac Rehabilitation of Conference Cum 10th Certificate Course in Cardiac Rehabilitation was held on 3-6 November 2016. It provided an excellent opportunity for sharing experience on practical issues of preventive cardiology and cardiac rehabilitation in Hong Kong. The Cardiovascular Interventional Summit 2016 was held on 16-18 December 2016 at the InterContinental Shenzhen, Shenzhen, China, it was one of the main and international intervention meetings of 2016. The CardioRhythm 2017, co-organized by the Hong Kong College of Cardiology and the Chinese Society of Pacing and Electrophysiology was held on 24-26 February 2017 and was also the 10th Anniversary of this conference. It provided an excellent opportunity for participants to remain abreast of the latest developments in the field of heart rhythm management. The 19th South China International Congress of Cardiology (SCC) was held on 6-9 April 2017 at Guangzhou Baiyun International Convention Centre, Guangzhou, China. HKCC members and spouses joined the delegation of Hong Kong College of Cardiology. The 25th Annual Scientific Congress of the College was held on 16-18 June 2017. It was the Silver Jubilee of the Congress and it has been continued to serve as an invaluable platform for exchange of ideas on treatment, researches and discoveries related to heart disease among professional. Throughout the year, the College has also organized a number of local scientific programmes.

Apart from the scientific programmes, the College is also actively involved in community projects to promote cardiovascular health. The Jump Rope for Heart Program continues its recruitment of school children for promotion of heart health through rope skipping. A number of projects for promotion and study of heart health in the community were also launched. The World Heart Day Carnival and Global Embrace which is scheduled on 12 November 2017, the yearly climax of our heart health promotion to the general public. To attract more attention towards our planning project Heart Safe Hong Kong, a large-scale training lesson of basic first aid, CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation), and AED (automated external defibrillation) named 千人齊習急救創紀錄 was held at Siu Sai Wan Sports Centre on 10 October 2016. Approximately 1,360 people including participants, volunteers, helpers, VIPs, instructors and media joined the event.

Regarding the training of local cardiology trainees, the College continues its involvement in the Hong Kong Heart Foundation Cardiology Training Fellowship Programme, which provides support for local cardiology trainees to undergo training in world renowned overseas centers.

The diversified and calendar-full activities organized by the College would not be successfully held without the dedication and active participation of its members, support of friends and the contribution of leading practitioners and academics both locally and abroad. The Council would like to take this opportunity to express its gratitude to them and will pledge to continue its mission in the years to come.

Devices, Atrial Fibrillation, Ablation, Heart Failure, Sudden Death, Arrhythmia Management, Syncope, Bradycardia Pacing and Tachycardia Therapy Device were developed and presented. Some of these were presented as joint symposia with American College of Cardiology, Asia Pacific Heart Rhythm Society (APHRS), Hong Kong Medical Association, Hong Kong Doctors Union, The Society of Physicians of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong College of Anaesthesiologists and World Society of Arrhythmias. Besides, the first time presented in CardioRhythm 2017, Global Grand Rounds was an interactive online live webcast session. Participants from Asia Pacific were invited to involve via online in the case studies related to the field of electrophysiology and CRDM. For the exhibition areas, we were delighted to have the generous support different companies and total 32 exhibitions booths were set up.

19th South China International Congress of Cardiology

The 19th South China International Congress of Cardiology (SCC) was held from 6-9 April 2017 at Guangzhou Baiyun International Convention Centre, Guangzhou, China. The College was one of the co-organizers and the aim of the Congress is to strengthen national and international academic exchange and up-to-date development in the field of cardiology. Renowned cardiologists from Europe, USA, Asia Pacific region, Mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan presented their research findings and reviews on advances in cardiovascular treatment.

Report on Community Activities

World Heart Day 2017 (世界心臟日)

Initiated by the World Heart Federation (WHF), World Heart Day has been fixed on 29 September every year and will be celebrated all over the world. This global programme aims to increase the awareness of the world population about prevention of heart disease, which is fast becoming the number one killer of the whole world. This year is the 17th Anniversary of World Heart Day in Hong Kong, and the College will continue to organize the World Heart Day Carnival 2017 which will be held on Sunday, 12 November 2017 with the theme “Share the power 凝聚力量 傳遞愛心”.

The Press Conference and the Kick-Off ceremony will be held in September 2017 and a series of activities will be held for the following months. Nine Public Heart Health Talks have been scheduled on 6, 13, 27 August; 10, 24 September; 8, 22 October and 5, 19 November 2017 at the Central Library, The Boy's & Girl's Clubs Association of Hong Kong and Science Museum. Over 3,000 citizens are expected to join the Global Embrace and the Heart Health Carnival which will include game booths, stage shows with singers/artistes and jump rope performances on 12 November 2017 at the Happy Valley Hong Kong Jockey Club. Jump Rope for Heart Program (JRFH) (跳繩強心) 2016-2017

The JRFH 2016-2017 was successfully held for the eighteenth year. Around 40,000 students from 82 primary schools and 18 secondary schools (a total of 100 schools) participated in the program this year. Over 1,000,000 students from 624 schools have joined the program over the past eighteen years.

The annual JRFH Inter-school Rope Skipping Competition is the climax of the year, and it provides an occasion for students to show their talents and to exchange skills with others. This year, 51 primary and 30 secondary school teams participated in the competition on 1 & 2 July 2017 at Southorn Stadium. The competition was divided into 6 groups: 4 groups for primary schools (A1, A2, B1 & B2) and 2 groups for secondary schools (A & B). The overall champions of each session were as follows:-

School visits by expert teams were conducted in 40 schools in this academic year. Students were all amazed by the wonderful performance of our elite skippers and they showed great interest in learning rope skipping. 35 heart health talks and 3 anti-drugs exhibitions (co-organized by JRFH & AMS) were conducted at JRFH participating schools in this academic year. Very positive feedback was received.

An elementary instructor certificate course was held on 4 December 2016 at Workers' Children Secondary School to introduce the program to around 60 teachers and elite skippers to train them the skills and techniques of teaching rope skipping at schools.

Schools that have participated in JRFH for 2 years or more were invited to apply for the Jump Rope for Heart School Activity Subsidy Program 2016 to conduct heart health educational or promotional programs at schools. The JRFH Finance Committee approved granting HK\$99,500 to 28 projects applied by 28 JRFH participating schools.

The JRFH Finance Committee agreed to share 50% of the actual subsidy, with the maximum of HK\$75,000, with HKCC to support the "Creative Fruity Venture - Secondary Schools Fruit Promotion Project 2016/17" organized by the Department of Health.

The JRFH Finance Committee approved granting HK\$50,000 to support the World Heart Day 2016. Several JRFH instructors set up a booth to teach the public participants to learn simple rope skipping skills. Winning teams of JRFH Inter-school Rope Skipping Competition 2016 and the champion team of World Rope Skipping Championships 2016 performed at the Heart Health Carnival.

The JRFH Finance Committee also approved granting HK\$30,000 and HK\$100,000 to support 6th APCCRC and the event “The World’s Largest First-aid Lesson” held on 10 October 2016 respectively.

The World Rope Skipping Championships 2016 (WRSC 2016) was held at Malmo, Sweden from 23 July to 2 August 2016. HKCC and JRFH each donated HK\$50,000 to support 127 athletes joining WRSC 2016. The Hong Kong Delegation was able to capture 27 gold, 26 silver and 26 bronze medals in this tournament. More delightfully, the male team (HK01) successfully defended the world championship title and broke the world record in “4 x 45 seconds Double Dutch relay”. The new world record is 671.5 times. The celebration dinner was held on 25 August 2016 at New World Millennium Hong Kong Hotel.

Heart Safe Hong Kong (HSHK)

A large-scale training lesson of basic first aid, CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation), and AED (automated external defibrillation) named 千人齊習急救創紀錄 was held at Siu Sai Wan Sports Centre on 10 Oct 2016. Approximately 1,360 people including participants, volunteers, helpers, VIPs, instructors and media joined the event.

Press Conference

Dr. LI Shu Kin, President of Hong Kong College of Cardiology, and Dr. LEE Lai Fun, Kathy, Chairlady of World Heart Day 2016 Finance Sub-Committee, were the speakers. They shared some news and data regarding sudden cardiac arrest and stated the low bystander CPR rate in Hong Kong. Dr. LEE also mentioned a training of AED and CPR built confidence in people to use AED when faced with a medical emergency. The importance message of AED and CPR spread out widely through newspapers, electronic media, online news, and mobile apps. It certainly reached beyond our thousand participants to their families, friends, and other citizens of Hong Kong. The master of ceremony were Dr. Prabowo TUNGGAL and Dr. CHEUNG Ling Ling.

Large-scale Training Lesson of Basic First Aid, CPR & AED

The lesson began with a CPR & AED demonstration by the Guest of Honor, Dr. KO Wing Man, BBS, JP, Secretary for Food and Health, and our Event Ambassador Mr. George LAM on the stage. We had 1,046 participants from 32 schools and supporting organizations attended the training of basic first-aid, CPR and AED which was taught by 110 instructors from Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Association. At the end of the event, many participants responded that the skills they learnt from the lesson were useful and they would recommend their friends to join such training in the future.

Annual General Meeting (AGM) 2017 of Paediatric Cardiology Chapter

The Annual General Meeting 2017 of the Paediatric Cardiology Chapter of the Hong Kong College of Cardiology was held on 16 March 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at Rooms A1 and A2, The Hong Kong Medical Association, Dr. Li Shu Pui Professional Education Centre, 2/F, Chinese Club Building, 21-22 Connaught Road Central, Hong Kong. Annual Report of the Paediatric Cardiology Chapter 2016 and the Accounts for the year ended 31 December 2016 of the Chapter were considered and adopted.

Working Group on Cardiac Computed Tomography

The current- status of cardiac CT

Cardiac CT is on the precipice and is starting to accelerate in growth greatly. Several trials have confirmed our clinical impression that cardiac CT offers a timely and efficient diagnosis of coronary artery disease, especially in the A&E department in patients with chest pain.

In four trials on patients with stable coronary artery disease, cardiac CT is more cost effective, faster and more efficient than the current standard of care, such as stress echo and stress nuclear, and is not more expensive. Cardiac CT is the most sensitive tools in the early diagnosis of coronary artery disease. Early plaques on the coronary arteries cannot be diagnosed on stress test or nuclear study which depends on the induction of myocardial ischemia.

Dramatic improvement in the technological aspects of CT means better spatial and temporal resolution with less radiation. The latest scanners, dedicated to cardiac CT, use 3 - 4 milli-Sivert (mSv.) of radiation routinely compare with around 15 mSv used by the standard 64 slice scanners. In properly prepared patients, scanning with sub mSv is possible. With the new interactive and model base image reconstruction software, plaque evaluations is feasible and follow up of such patient using serial CT is a possibility, given the low radiation involved.

CT- FFR is now FDA approved for the non-invasive haemodynamic assessment of the entire coronary tree. This gives CT the ability to provide not only anatomical but physiological information. However, the company which pioneers the technology, HeartFlow, requires the images to be sent to their facility for evaluation. Such practice makes it difficult for operators outside the United States to make use of the technology. The use of alternative algorithm is being explored by various vendors.

Cardiac CT has been used routinely for the assessment of patients undergoing TAVI. New software is now available to evaluate the anatomy of the aortic root and to evaluate which artificial valve fit the anatomy best. This will ensure the availability of such a device in the catheter laboratory during intervention.

The use of 3D printing from data provided by cardiac CT has been used in structural intervention such as left atrial appendage closure. Cardiac CT is increasingly used in the field of structural heart disease prior to intervention. Challenging anatomy will be recognised and the appropriate solution available before intervention.

The use of cardiac CT is expanding. Its use in the strategic planning of PCI has now expanded to structural heart disease. Cardiac CT should be part of the curriculum for doctors with an interest in cardiology.
